We act for continuous improvement every day because safety is a value that impacts on everyone's professional and personal life.







## **Accreditation / Qualification Process**

Dedicated Process



Purpose: identification and evaluation of Contractors with a high professional and ethical standard, adhering to the values and principles of the Snam Group, including the promotion of a safe and healthy workplaces and environmental protection.

#### **Regulatory requirements**

- Social security contributions declarations
- Licenses, accreditation to professional bodies etc.
- Compliance with law (public procurement, safety, ecc.)

#### **Ethical Requirements**

- Code of ethics
- Procedures to prevent risks
- Anti-mafia
- Compliance with the contents of the «Ethics and Integrity Pact»

#### **Business Requirements**

- HSEQ
- Economic Financial stability
- Organizational structure

### Accreditation / Qualification Process

Dedicated Process
Rule





- 1 Acceptance-Check in:
  - Self-application/Internal proposal of a Contractor/Group of goods
  - Admission to the qualification/accreditation process either for application, or extension, or renewal
- 3 Conclusion and Vendor Management

If the checks have been completed with a green light the Contractor enters the VL with "qualified/accredited" status.

# Execution – Intermediate/Final Feedback

Dedicated process Rule



- Prepared by the Contract Manager
- The Contract Manager considers also HSE site evidences
- In case of **negative feedback**, depending on the extent of the contractual violation, **actions might be undertaken** such as:
  - Warning
  - Limitation
  - Qualifications suspensions
  - Qualifications withdrawal

For suspensions, a **detailed taxonomy is implemented (HSE, Quality, Behaviour, Punctuality)** within the process. In the following some examples related to HSE:

Lack of training/information on the HSE aspects of the personnel on the construction site

2 months

Serious violation of the HSE regulations in the working areas assigned to the Contractor by the Customer

4 months

Fatality or occupational accident with more than 60 days prognosis

6 months



### **Execution - Contractors HSE Audit**





#### **Plan 2023**

#### **Audit HSE Contractors (42)**

- Transport: 38 (18 network, 3 plans, 17 construction)
- Storage: 2
- Regasification: 2

+ 43% vs 2022

#### Year 2022:

- 30 audit HSE (+ 50% vs 2021)
- Main findings: documentation mngt, use of PPE and maintenance of equipment/vehicles.

#### First quarter 2023:

- 17 audit HSE
- 92 Total findings
- Main findings: site documentation, maintenance of equipment/vehicles, emergency plans, fire prevention, PPE, HazMat mngt, driving s and waste mngt.
